ACHIEVEMENT Early April. Semi-double, 2" white flowers with a greenish-yellow throat. Full, upright habit. ☼

ADDY WERY March. 1 3/4" red flowers with an orange-red blotch. Upright habit. (Kurume) ☼

ADELAIDE POPE Late March. Single, 2" bright purplish-red flowers. Nice glossy foliage. (Carla)

ADZORA (see TAKASAGO)

AIKOKU(f) Mid May. 2½", single white flowers with purplish-pink stripes. Low and spreading. (Satsuki)

AIOI (see FAIRY QUEEN)

ALADDIN Late April-May. Single, deep pink with a lighter center and darker dots. Semi-deciduous. (Glenn Dale)

ALASKA(f) Mid March. Single to double, 2" white flowers with a yellow-green blotch. (Rutherford)

ALEXANDER Early May. Single, 2" orange-red flowers. Small, glossy, pointed leaves. Low, creeping habit. Good for rock gardens or cascading over walls. Very hardy. (North Tisbury)

ALLURE Mid March. Single, soft pink with darker pink spotting. Spreading habit. (Glenn Dale)

EVERGREEN AZALEAS

AMAGHASA April. 3", single, orange-red flowers. Low, spreading habit. (Satsuki)

AMBROSIA April. Single, 2", orange-pink flowers shading to a lighter color. (Glenn Dale)

AMBROSIA VARIEGATED(f) (*syn. VIRGINA STEWART*) Late March-April. Double, 1½" rosy-red flowers on a low-growing azalea with strongly variegated foliage. (Belgian Indica)

AMOENA PURPLE(f) Mid March. Small, hose-in-hose, purple-red flowers with some cerise-red spotting. Upright, spreading habit. (Kurume) ☼

AMOENA RED(f) Mid March. Hose-in-hose, bright red flowers. Upright, spreading habit. ☼ (Kurume)

ANGEL WING Late May. 1" medium-pink flowers. Low, cascading habit. (Satsuki)

ANNE H.(f) Late February-March. 3", semi-double, very pale pink to white flowers.

APHRODITE Late April. 1½" salmon-pink flowers. Upright, spreading habit. (Glenn Dale)

APPLE BLOSSOM Mid March. 1½" apple-blossom-pink flowers with a white throat. ☼ (Kurume)

AUDREY BARBER(f) Late March. Large, semi-double, white with greenish-yellow throat. ☼ (SHN)

AUTUMN JOY(f) Late March. Beautiful hose-in-hose, 2" flowers are deep pink. (SHN)

AVALANCHE Mid March. Single, 1½" white flowers. Heavy bloomer. ☼ (Kurume)

AZTECA JOY Late March-April. Large, semi-double, dark coral-pink flowers with ruffled edges.

BANJO NO TSUKI Early May. 4" white flowers with red stripes. (Satsuki)

BARBER'S ORANGE(f) Late March. Semi-double, ruffled, 2" orange-red flowers. (SHN)

BARBER'S PURPLE Late March. Semi-double, 2" bright purple flowers. Full, spreading habit. (SHN)

BAYON(f) Late March. Single, 1" white flowers. Compact grower. ☼ (Kurume)

BEACON April. Deep salmon-pink. Upright, arching habit. (Glenn Dale)

BEN MORRISON(f) Late March. Single flowers are pink with a white edge and darker pink markings. (Glenn Dale)

BENI BOTAN(f) Late May. Double, 2½", orange-red flowers with darker dots in petals. Rounded leaves. (Satsuki)

BENI KIRISHIMA May. Double, 2" orange-red with a darker blotch. (Satsuki)

BESS HALLOCK(f) Early May. 2" dark pink flowers with a red blotch. Very compact grower. (Linwood)

BETTY(f) Early April. 2", single orange-red flowers with a darker red throat. (Kaempferi)

BLAAUW'S PINK Early April. Hose-in-hose, 2" deep coral-pink flowers. ☼ (Kurume)

BLUE DANUBE Early April. Single, 2" purple-red flowers with a darker blotch. Upright, spreading habit. ☼ (Kaempferi)

BLUE MOON Late May-June. 1½", lavender-pink flowers with a white center. (Satsuki)

BLUE SKIES (f) Late March. 1", lavender-pink flowers. Compact habit. (Kurume)

BLUE TIP(f) May. 2" flowers of deep lavender-pink with a white center. ☼ (Robin Hill)

BLUSHING MAID Late March-April. 2½" dark purple-pink flowers. Upright habit. (Glenn Dale)

BOLD FACE(f) Mid April. 3" white flowers with lavender-pink margins and a red blotch. (Glenn Dale.)

BOUNTIFUL Late April-May. Filled, 3" reddish-purple flowers. Broad, spreading habit. (Glenn Dale)

breviperulatum '82-088 RSF' Late March-April. 1" pastel rose-purple flowers with magenta flecks and a reddish blotch. Low and spreading habit. (species)

BRIDE'S BOUQUET Mid April. Small, double, white flowers resemble mini-roses. (Kerrigan)

BRIDESMAID(f) Mid March. Single, 1½" bright salmon-pink flowers. Spreading habit. (Kurume)

BRILLIANT (syn. *BRILLIANTINA*) April-May. Single, 2½" bright pink flowers. Spreading habit. ☼ (Southern Indica)

BUCCANEER Late April. Single, 2½" dark red-orange flowers. Upright growth habit. ☼ (Glen Dale)

BUNKWA Mid May. 2", creamy-pink flowers with darker spots and a greenish eye. (Satsuki)

CABARET Early April. Semi-double, 2" white flowers with a deep pink margin. (Belgian Indica)

CALIFORNIA SUNSET(f) Late March. Medium-sized, double, salmon-pink flowers with white edges. Very showy flowers. (Belgian Indica)

CAMEO Late April. 1½", rosy-pink, hose-in-hose flowers. Upright, spreading habit. (Glenn Dale)

CAMPFIRE Early March. Hose-in-hose, 1½", bright red flowers with a darker red blotch. (Gable)

CAN-CAN May. Ruffled, double, 3" bluish-pink flowers. Compact habit. (Greenwood)

CAPITOLA(f) April. 2", light pink flowers with a red blotch. (Kerrigan)

CAPTAIN BLOOD Mid April. Semi-double, 2" dark red flowers. Dark green foliage. (Kerrigan)

CARMEL Mid April. Single, 1½" orange-red flowers. Nice growth habit. (Glenn Dale)

CAROLINE GABLE(f) Early April. 1½", deep red flowers with darker centers. (Gable)

EVERGREEN AZALEAS

CATTLEYA(f) Mid March. 1½" white flowers flushed with lavender-pink. ☼ (Kurume)

CHANTICLEER April. 2" purple-red flowers with a lighter center. (Glenn Dale)

CHERRY BLOSSOM (syn. *OGIKASANE*) Late March. Hose-in-hose, 1½" white flowers flushed with soft pink. ☼ (Kurume)

CHERRY DELIGHT SPORT(f) Late March. Small, bright carmine-red flowers. Very compact. ☼ (Kurume)

CHERRY RIPE Mid March. Hose-in-hose, 1½" vivid red flowers. ☼ (Kurume)

CHICHIBU Late May-June. Single, 3" pale pink flowers with darker pink splashes. (Satsuki)

CHIKYUHO Late April-May Irregular, double, 2" flowers are coral pink, fading to white in the center. (Satsuki)

CHINEI Late May-June. 3" variable light pink to dark pink flowers with a darker blotch. (Satsuki)

CHINOIDES Late March-April. Single, 2" bright red flowers. ☼ (Kurume)

CHINSAI(f) (syn. *HANA FABUKI*) Mid May. Single, star-shaped, 1" white flowers with rose stripes and flecks. (Satsuki)

CHINSEI May. Single, 2" dark pink flowers with a red blotch. (Satsuki)

CHINZAN Early May. Single, 2" deep pink flowers with a darker blotch. (Satsuki)

CHITOSE NISHIKI Early May. Single, 2" white flowers. Spreading habit. (Satsuki)

CHIYO NO TSUKI Early May. Small, single, white with stripes of deep coral-red. (Satsuki)

CHLOE April. 2", vivid purple-red flowers. Pubescent foliage. Upright, spreading habit. (Glenn Dale)

CHOJUHO(f) Mid May. Small, brilliant red flowers with unusual petals that change from red to green. Long lasting blossoms. (Satsuki)

CHO NO HAGOROMO June. Single, 2" white flowers with yellow centers. (Satsuki)

CHRISTIE Early May. Large, single, light pink with dark pink stripes. (Robin Hill)

CHRISTMAS CHEER (see *IMA SHOJO*)

CINNABAR Early May. Single, 2" white flowers with cinnabar-red stripes and sectors. (Glenn Dale)

CIRCLE ONE Mid April. Single, 2½" pink or white flowers. Dark green foliage. Low spreading habit. (Satsuki)

CITIGO SUGATA(f) Mid April. Large, single flowers are orange-red with a white center. (Satsuki)

CLOUD NINE(f) Mid March. Double, 2" pure white flowers resemble mini-roses. Dark green foliage. Compact habit. (Kerrigan)

- CONVERSATION PIECE** Late March. 3", white flowers with purplish-pink variations. (Robin Hill)
- COPPERMAN** Early May. Single, 2½" bright orange-red flowers. (Glenn Dale)
- CORAL BELLS(f)** Mid March. 1½" coral pink, hose-in-hose flowers. Compact growth habit. Long blooming period. ☼ (Kurume)
- CORAL DOGWOOD** Late May-June. Hose-in-hose, 2" deep coral pink flowers. Glossy, dark green foliage.
- CORAL MAY QUEEN** Early April. Double, 2" dark coral-pink flowers resemble mini-roses. A sport of 'MAY QUEEN'. (Kerrigan)
- CORAL SEA** April. 1½" light coral-pink flowers with pointed petals. (Chisolm-Merritt)
- CORAL SEA G.D.** May. 2½" dark pink flowers with red spots. (Glenn Dale)
- CORAL WINGS** Late March. Single, 2" deep coral-red flowers with a darker blotch.
- CORDIAL** April. Frilled, 3" purple-red flowers. Spreading habit. (Glenn Dale)
- DAINTY ROSE** Late March. 2" rosy-pink flowers. Grows wider than tall. ☼ (Beltsville Dwarf)
- DAISEIKO** (*syn. GREAT STARLIGHT*) Late May-June. Variable, 2½" flowers have pointed lobes and are white with pink stripes, flakes, and selfs. (Satsuki)
- DAWN(f)** March. Single, 1½" soft pink flowers with darker spotting. (Kaempferi)
- DAYSRING(f)** Mid March. Single, 2" pink flowers fading to white in the center. (Glenn Dale)
- DEBUTANTE(f)** Mid March. Single, 1½" white with salmon-pink margins. ☼ (Kurume)
- DELICATISSIMA** Mid March. Single, 1½" white flowers with soft lavender-pink edges. Upright, dense growth habit. ☼ (Kurume)
- DELOS(f)** Early April. Double, 2" medium-pink flowers. (Glenn Dale)
- DEWAELE'S FAVOURITE** April. 2½", variegated pink and white flowers. (Belgian Indica)
- DIMITY** March. Single, 2" white flowers with red-purple flakes and stripes. Upright habit. (Glenn Dale)
- DOGWOOD(f)** (*syn. BLANCA*) Mid April. Single, 2½" white flowers with an occasional pink stripe.
- DOLLY PARTON** Late March-April. Large, semi-double, pink flowers with a dark blotch.
- DOROTHY CLARK** Late April-May. 4" pale pink flowers with red edges. (Harris)
- DOROTHY GISH(f)** Mid March. Frilled, orange-red flowers. Hose-in-hose. (Rutherford)
- DREAM(f)** Mid March. Pink flowers with a darker pink blotch. (Glenn Dale)

- DUC DE ROHAN(f)** Mid April. 2½" deep pink flowers with an orange red blotch. Dark green foliage. ☼ (Southern Indica)
- EASTER PARADE** Late April-May. Ruffled, semi-double, 3" deep pink flowers with a lighter center. (Belgian Indica)
- EIKAN** Early May. Single, 3" coral-pink flowers with a lighter center. (Satsuki)
- EIKO** Late April. Single, 3" white flowers with pink stripes. (Satsuki)
- EILEEN(f)** Early March. Hose-in-hose, 1½" peach-pink flowers with a white throat. Long blooming period. ☼ (Kurume)
- EISHI** May. 2" white flowers with an occasional purple fleck. (Satsuki)
- ELIZABETH GABLE** Late May. Hose-in-hose, 2" pink flowers with a darker blotch. (Gable)
- ELSA(f)** Mid April. Pink flushed white on the edges with a red blotch. (Robin Hill)

- EVENSONG(f)** Mid March. Single, 2" white flowers. Upright, full growth habit. (Glenn Dale)
- EVEREST** April. 2" white flowers with a chartreuse throat. (Glenn Dale)
- FAIRY** March. 1" white flowers with a red-orange blotch. ☼ (Kurume)
- FAIRY QUEEN(f)** (*syn. AIOI*) Late March-April. Hose-in-hose, 2" soft pink flowers with lighter shades and red spots. ☼ (Kurume)
- FASHION(f)** Early April. Orange-red, 2" hose-in-hose flowers with a darker blotch. (Glenn Dale)
- FAVORITE** Late April-May. 1½" white flowers with red stripes. (Glenn Dale)
- FAWN** Late March. 2½" bright lavender-pink flowers with pointed petals. (Glenn Dale)
- FEDORA** April. 2" medium-pink flowers with a darker throat. (Kaempferi)
- FESTIVAL** April-May. Ruffled, 2" white flowers with pink variations. Dark green foliage. (Satsuki)
- FESTIVE(f)** Mid April. Large, single, white with rosy-pink stripes. (Glenn Dale)
- FIELDER'S WHITE** Mid May. 2½" white flowers with a greenish yellow blotch. Full, spreading habit. ☼ (Southern Indica)
- FIRMAMENT** Late May. 2" salmon-pink flowers with a white center. Full, upright growth habit. (Satsuki)
- FIRST PRIZE** Late April. Double, 2" white flowers blushed with pink. (Satsuki)
- FIRST SNOW(f)** Late March-April. Semi-double, 2" white flowers opening from rose-colored buds. Glossy dark green foliage.
- FLAME** (*see SUETSUMA*)

FLAME CREEPER(f) Early May. Single, 2" orange-red flowers. Low creeping habit. Small, dark green foliage. (Indicum clone)

FORMOSA (see *PHOENICIA*)

FRILLS April. Double, 2 ½", ruffled red flowers. (SHN)

FRIVOLITY May. Single, 2" white flowers with occasional dark pink flecks. (Glenn Dale)

FUJI MORI Late May. Single, 1½" soft pink flowers with long, narrow, pointed petals. Pink stems. (Satsuki)

FUJI NISHIKI Late May. Single, 2" white flowers striped and flecked with purple-red. Quite variable. (Satsuki)

FUJI ZAKURA May. 2" white flowers with pink stripes. (Satsuki)

FUKI Late May. Tubular, 1" salmon-pink flowers with a dark throat. Narrow, dark green foliage and a dense, mounding growth habit. ✨ (SHN)

FURBELOW Late April. Single, 2" white flowers with occasional red flecks. (Glenn Dale)

GAIIETY Late April-May. 2" bright pink flowers. Handsome foliage. (Glenn Dale)

GALATHEA Early May. Single, 1½" dark orange-red flowers with darker red dots. (Glenn Dale)

GARDEN STATE GLOW Mid March. Hose-in-hose, 2½" bright pink flowers. (Linwood)

GARDEN STATE SALMON Mid March. Hose-in-hose, 2½" coral orange flowers. (Linwood)

GARDEN STATE WHITE Mid March. Hose-in-hose, 2½" white flowers. Compact growth habit. (Linwood)

GAY PAREE Early April. Semi-double, 2" white flowers with bright pink frilled edges. (Kerrigan)

GEISHA(f) Mid March. 2" white flowers with a chartreuse blotch. Tall, spreading habit. ✨ (Glenn Dale)

GEISHA #2(f) (syn. *GEISHA, TOO*) Mid March. 2" white flowers with variations of pink stripes and flecks. ✨ (Loblolly Bay)

GEORGE LINDLEY TABER (syn. ...*LINDSEY...or G.L.TABER*) Late April. Single, 3" white flowers are flushed pale pink and have a large red blotch. Upright tall grower. Light green foliage. ✨ (Southern Indica)

GETSUTOKU Mid May. Large white flowers with an orange-red blotch and salmon-pink stripes and selfs. (Satsuki)

G.G. GERBING (syn. *MRS. G.G. GERBING*) Late March. Large, single, white flowers. Light green foliage. Sport of 'G.L. TABER'. ✨ (Southern Indica)

GIRARD'S FUCHSIA(f) March. 2½", single fuchsia-pink flowers. (Girard)

GLACIER Mid April. 2½" white flowers with a faint green tone. Dark green foliage. ✨ (Glenn Dale)

GLENCORA Early May. Semi-double, 2" salmon-pink flowers with a lighter center. (Robin Hill)

#140 Single, 2" deep pink flowers.

#143 Single, 2" salmon-orange flowers.

GREENWOOD ORANGE(f) Late April. Double, 1½" orange-red flowers. ✨ (Greenwood)

GULF STREAM Late-March. Single, 3" soft lavender flowers with lighter shades and some fragrance. ✨ (Southern Indica)

GUMPO PINK Mid May-June. 2", ruffled, light pink flowers. Round, shiny leaves. Dwarf. (Satsuki)

GUMPO ROSE (see *YUGIRI*)

GUMPO WHITE(f) Mid May. Ruffled, 2" white flowers. Round, shiny leaves. Dwarf. (Satsuki)

GUNBI Late April-May. Single, 2" pink flowers shading to blush pink in the center.

GUNJO Mid April. 3" salmon-pink flowers with a darker blotch. (Satsuki)

GWENDA Mid April-May. 2" light creamy-pink flowers. Semi-dwarf. (Robin Hill)

GYOKUDO Early April. Single, star-shaped, 1½" white flowers with bright orange tips. (Satsuki)

GYOKUSHIN Mid May. Single, 3" light pink flowers with an attractive red blotch. (Satsuki)

HAGOROMO NO HIKARI June. Single, star-shaped, 1½" flowers with white centers and red edges. (Satsuki)

HAKATA SHIRO Mid May. Single, 2" white flowers with a chartreuse throat. Low, spreading habit. (Indicum clone)

- HARDIJZER'S BEAUTY** (*Azaleodendron*) Mid March-April. 1" clear pink flowers in a ball-shaped truss. Bronze-colored winter foliage. Prolific bloomer. ☼ (racemosum x Kurume hybrid)
- HARDY FIREFLY** Mid March. Single, 2" orange-red flowers. ☼ (Kurume)
- HARDY GARDENIA** April. Double, 2" white flowers. Dark green foliage. (Linwood)
- HARLEQUIN** Late April-May. Single, 3" white flowers with fuchsia-purple stripes and flecks. (Glenn Dale)
- HARU GASUMI** May-June. 2½" pink flowers with white centers and dark pink edges. Dark green foliage. (Wada)
- HARU NO HIBIKI** (f) May. Double, 2" white flowers with deep pink edges. (Satsuki)
- HARU NO SONO** June. 3" white flowers with bright pink stripes. (Satsuki)
- HARU NO UMI** Late May-June. Single, 3" bright pink flowers. Dark green foliage. (Satsuki)
- HARUNUM** (see *SHIRYU NO HOMARE*)
- HEIWA** Mid May. 2½" white flowers with red-purplish sectors and stripes. (Satsuki)
- HELEN CLOSE** April. Single, 3½" white flowers with a chartreuse center. (Glenn Dale)
- HERBERT** Early April. Frilled, single, 2½" medium-purple flowers with a deeper purple blotch. (Gable)
- HERSHEY'S ORANGE** (f) Mid March-April. 1" deep orange-pink flowers. Glossy foliage. ☼ (Kurume)
- HERSHEY'S PINK**(f) Mid March-April. 1½" deep coral-pink flowers. Glossy foliage. ☼ (Kurume)
- HERSHEY'S RED**(f) Mid March-April. Semi-double, 1½" bright red flowers. Glossy foliage. ☼ (Kurume)
- HESSEL**(f) Mid March. Frilled, 2", hose-in-hose, deep red flowers. Dark green foliage. (SHN)
- HEXE**(f) Early April. Frilled, 2½" carmine-red flowers. Dark green foliage. (Sanders)
- HIGASA** Early May. 3" light salmon-pink flowers with a dark spotted throat. (Satsuki)
- HIME KAGAMI** Mid March. Hose-in-hose, 1" white flowers. ☼ (Kurume)
- HINO CRIMSON**(f) Mid April. 1" crimson flowers. Low compact habit. ☼ (Kurume)

- HINO ORANGE**(f) Mid April. 1", single orange-pink flowers. ☼ (Kurume)
- HINO TSUKASA** Mid May. Single, 2" reddish-orange flowers. (Satsuki)
- HINO WHITE**(f) Mid April. 1" white flowers. Low, dense habit. ☼ (Shamarello)
- HINODE GIRI**(f) Mid April. 1" bright red flowers. Low, compact habit. ☼ (Kurume)
- HO ODEN**(f) Mid March. 2½" soft pink flowers with white edges and a red blotch. ☼ (Mucronatum clone)
- HOSHI NO SATO**(f) Mid May. 2½" pale pink to white flowers margined with darker pink. Handsome variegated foliage. (Satsuki)
- HOSHUN** Late May-June. 2" white flowers with orange red tips. Very narrow petals. Low, spreading habit. (Satsuki)
- HOT SHOT VARIEGATED**(f) Late March. 1½" bright red flowers on a low growing plant with striking white and green variegated leaves.
